***GIRLS OPPORTUNITY for LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT (G.O.L.D.)***

The Lansdale Branch of AAUW enjoys a long tradition of promoting positive societal change as part of our mission. In the spirit of this tradition the G.O.L.D. program was designed in response to research indicating that a girls' confidence and self-esteem drop significantly during the middle school years. The Lansdale AAUW first offered G.O.L.D. to eighth-grade girls in the North Penn school district in 1997 in partnership with the NPSD Community Education Program. In addition to the school district, our sponsors include local businesses and community groups. The program is designed for eighth-grade girls who are split into small groups led by two or more high school girls serving as core group leaders.

G.O.L.D. is an evening program which runs from 6 p.m. until 12:00 midnight. The goal of the program is to positively influence girls so they can feel confident in taking responsibility for their choices. Activities are designed to help girls build their self-confidence and develop their skills to think for themselves and step up to leadership challenges. In addition to the workshops, the night offers fun activities such as making a craft, enjoying a pizza party, and developing new friendships.

Over the years, more than one thousand girls have experienced G.O.L.D.. The program consistently receives positive feedback from the eighth-grade and high school girls. Many of the eighth-graders wish they could go again the next year. We feel it is one of the most important programs we offer to young women in our community, our leaders of tomorrow. If we can in some small way make a girl feel good about herself, to trust her instincts and leadership abilities, then we have accomplished our goal.
